- No prior criminal record
- Must not have any connection to an offender in the prison nor should you be pending admittance to the institution for any other reason.

Selection Process:

Unfortunately not all Legal Studies students can join us on this trip. The prison trip is reserved for 24 fourth-year Legal Studies students. Why only 24? Out of respect for integrity of the prison and those within, Corrections Canada prefer smaller groups of students. Attached, students will find an application form. Please fill out this application and return it to the Legal Studies Society Office, or to the Legal Studies Society dropbox on the second floor of SJU. Names of the successful applicants will be put into a jar and the first 24 will be notified. 10 subsequent names will be drawn and added to a short list. These individuals will have 48 hours to issue a cheque to the order of The Legal Studies Society. Applications unaccompanied by cheques after the 48 hours will be discarded and the first name will be selected from the short list. We hope that this process creates a fair and understandable solution to ensure all applications are treated equally.

Respect and Etiquette:

Visiting a Correctional Institution requires a set level of maturity, respect, and etiquette. Though you may hold your personal views towards the individuals within the confines of these institutions, this prison trip is not meant for you to

share such thoughts. This trip is educational; Corrections Canada demands respect for the inmates and for the institutions.

In addition, while on this trip, you will be representing the University of Waterloo, St. Jerome's University, the Department of Sociology and Legal Studies, the Legal Studies Society, and those who organized this opportunity. You will be held to an exceptionally high level of maturity and respect. Those who fail to meet these expectations will be asked to return to the bus or face the consequences prescribed by Corrections Canada.

***Disclaimer:** Chosen applicants will be subjected to a background check by Corrections Canada. All the information asked on this application is required. Your information may be shared with Professors, the Executive of the Legal Studies Society, and Corrections Canada. If required to share such information with other groups or agencies, you will be notified.

Other:

There will be restrictions on what can be worn during the trip (this will include clothing designs and patterns and jewelry). Please be advised that the Legal Studies Society will reserve the right to withhold access to the bus if you do not meet the requirements set out by Corrections Canada. More information will be provided as to what will be required of each student.

The cost of this trip will be \$30.00 per students: this cost includes transportation, food, and drink. Payment is required upon successful selection of students.
